## KEY ASPECTS OF THE IMPORTANCE OF NEP 2020:

**1. Holistic and Skill-Based Development:** NEP 2020 moves away from rote, exam-oriented learning to foster conceptual understanding, critical thinking, and creativity. It includes early integration of vocational skills and AI-powered personalized learning to prepare students for real-world challenges.

**2. Flexible Higher Education:** NEP 2020 enables multidisciplinary education, multiple entry and exit points, an academic credit bank, and the establishment of the National Research Foundation (NRF) to boost research and innovation.

**3. Inclusivity and Equality:** The policy prioritizes educational inclusion through special education zones and gender inclusion funds, aiming to bridge gaps for underrepresented and disadvantaged groups.

**4. Empowering Teachers:** Continuous professional development, merit-based career progression, and high-quality teacher education are central to restoring and elevating the status of teachers.

**5. Language and Technology:** NEP 2020 advocates teaching in students' mother tongue or regional language until at least Grade 5. It also encourages the integration of technology in classrooms and teacher training for more effective learning outcomes.



## New National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020)



## KEY CHANGES IN TECHNICAL EDUCATION:

**1. Multiple Entry/Exit Options:** Students can receive a certificate after 1 year, a diploma after 2 years, or a bachelor's degree after 3 or 4 years.

**2. Multidisciplinary Education:** Establishment of MERUs (Multidisciplinary Education and Research Universities).

**3. Academic Bank of Credits (ABC):** Digital storage of academic credits to facilitate transferring between institutions.

**4. Regulatory Overhaul:** The Higher Education Commission of India (HECI) will serve as a single umbrella body (excluding medical and legal education).

**5. Internationalization:** Top foreign universities are permitted to establish campuses in India.

## KEY OBJECTIVES :

**1. Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER):** Strive to increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio in technical education to 50% by 2035, aligning with national educational goals.

**2. PARAKH Implementation:** Establish and collaborate with the new national assessment centre, PARAKH, to guide and standardise assessment methodologies, ensuring quality and consistency across evaluation processes.

**3. Focus on Technology:** Integrate advanced technology in teaching, learning, and educational planning to enhance student engagement, improve learning outcomes, and streamline academic operations.
