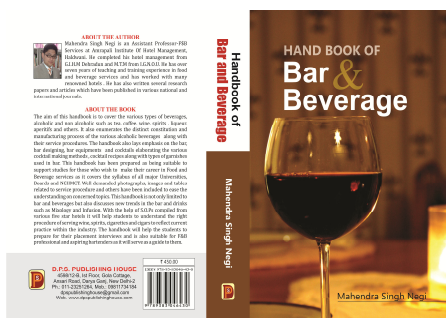
### 3. Equipment Received at SIHMCT & AN, New Tehri
